


Fig. 2: Comparison between fovea and its outer portions. Area1 corresponds to fovea, area 2 to parafovea, areas 3 and area 4 to the outer portions.




Fig.3. Comparison between fovea and its outer portions. Mean and standard error of N1 latency (**A**), N1 amplitude (**B**), P1 latency (**C**), and P1 amplitude (**D**) at four different stimulus sites illustrated in Figure 2.




Fig.4. Comparison between the upper retina (lower half array) and lower retina (upper half array).




Fig.5. Comparison between the nasal and temporal retina, the portion that included the optic disc and the nasal portion corresponding to this black circular portion was excluded from the summation.
