

POSITIVE AND NEGATIVE SENSORY SYMPTOMS

- Dysesthesia (e.g. prickling)
- Paresthesia (e.g. pins and needles)
- Spontaneous neuropathic pain (e.g. burning, shooting)
- Hyperesthesia and/or hyperalgesia (e.g. mechanical, thermal)
- Hypoesthesia and/or hypoalgesia (e.g. mechanical, thermal)
- Allodynia
- Decreased sense of vibration and proprioception
- Impaired fine motor skills
- Sensory ataxia



MOTOR SYMPTOMS

- Paresis
- Muscle wasting or cramps
- Attenuated reflexes

AUTONOMIC SYMPTOMS

- Orthostatic hypertension
- Cardiovascular dysfunction
- Urogenital dysfunction
- Gastroparesis
- Sexual dysfunction
