
## POSITIVE AND NEGATIVE SENSORY SYMPTOMS

- Dysesthesia (e.g. prickling)
  Paresthesia (e.g. pins and needles)
  Spontanous neuropathic pain (e.g. burning, shooting)
  Hyperesthesia and/or hyperalgesia (e.g. mechanical, thermal)
- Hypoesthesia and/or hypoalgesia (e.g. mechanical, thermal)
   Allodynia
   Decreased sense of vibration and

  Impaired fine motor skills
